
why is this tough?



55% of adult Americans now have broadband internet connections at home 10% of people have dial-up 25% of low income people don't have bb at home. Half of Americans between the ages of 50 and 64 have broadband at home. Some 19% of those 65 and older have home broadband access as of April 2008. dialup is getting more expensive as broadband is getting cheaper.

why no internet?


- 19% of dial-up users said **nothing** would convince them to get broadband.
- 14% of dial-up users (24% in rural America) say that broadband service would have to **become** available where they live.
- one-quarter (27%) of adult Americans are not internet users

- Broadband "not sufficiently relevant for them"




A lot of this comes down to helping people solve problems, and saving money is one of the bigger problems you can help them with.







Ask "what is my motivation" and apply this to your patrons. What problem does technology SOLVE for them in exchange for the ones it may create?





TRANSCRIPT OF THE INTERVIEW WITH SANDRA ROSE FRIEDMAN

Note: The first portion of this interview was inadvertently destroyed. For more information concerning Sandra Rose Friedman's origins and early childhood please refer to the autobiography written in 1998.

The following is a summary of the lost content prepared by the Interviewer:

On May 25, 2002 Judith Kent interviewed Sandra Rose Friedman at the Flagler County Public Library. While describing her earliest memories Mrs. Friedman recalled a pulley designed to hoist bales of mattress filling to the second story of the family's factory. She remembered the fun of trying to hoist herself up on the pulley. The family living quarters were over their factory in Newark, New Jersey. There her mother, Mirel sewed the mattress covers and her father, Nathan stuffed them. Sandra Rose was cared for by a nurse who spoke only Yiddish while her parents worked. Yiddish was spoken in not too tough!






