# control/filter issues

- Over & Underblocking
- More controls = more confusion
- Privacy/trust/free speech
- False sense of security?

# control can't...

- Stop kids from oversharing
- Stop kids from bullying
- Block incoming contact (often)
- Teach social norms/expectations

# safety vs. legality

- Separate issues, usually
- Call police on legal issues
- Ask school officials if you're not sure
